Accredited Training Explained

In Australia, we have three different levels of education:

- School (primary and secondary)
- VET (vocational education & training)
- University (higher education)



In VET, if a course is accredited, it means the course is nationally recognised and that a registered training organisation (RTO) can issue a nationally recognised VET qualification or VET statement of attainment following its full or partial completion. VET qualifications can be offered at different levels starting from Certificate I through to Graduate Diplomas. These are part of the Australian Qualifications Framework.

NBMC offers a range of full qualification and short courses which are identified with the above logo as they are "accredited".

The content of each accredited course is drawn from a Training Package which is a set of nationally endorsed standards and qualifications for recognising and assessing people's skills in a specific industry.

RTOs in NSW (this includes most Community Colleges, TAFEs and private RTOs) are registered with the Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA) to deliver training. To operate as an RTO we are all required to meet stringent standards and audited regularly by ASQA to ensure compliance with those standards.




